- Master thesis title 'Revitalization of industrial complex KTK Visoko into multifunctional uses'. As we have passed the era of industry, formal and organizational changes occur in the cities worldwide. In the past twenty years, many European countries started to deal with the abundant industrial sites. Brownfields are perceived as a great potential to revive non central areas of the city, improve social and cultural life and decrease contamination. Bosnia and Herzegovina with its rich history is rich in industrial sites as well. One of important and carrying strong cultural memory sites is KTK Leather Factory. It is valuable cultural and industrial heritage. Since Bosnia and Herzegovina has not undertaken yet any project regarding transforming or revitalizing industrial sites, master thesis paper aims to conduct a research on industrial revitalization in Bosnia and Herzegovina and offer a solution of revitalization of KTK in Visoko. The goal is, through the research, analyses, observations, comparisons, to describe why this site is important to revitalize and to indicate the ways in which it could be done, in terms of its usage, in order to provide new usage needed in the city, usage that is appropriate for the site, and influences socioeconomic development of Visoko.
